





Hony. Sports Secretary's Report

For the years 2003-04, 2004-05 (upto Feb. 2005)

I am happy to present the report for Association's sports activities during the year 2004-05 and also give a resume of the important events that have taken place during the period from 1st April 2004 to date.

To begin with, we have been regular in our sports and games activities which are organized on Sundays and Holidays. While sports do take a back seat for obvious reasons, games, particularly of cricket, is greatly enjoyed by our young members, some of whom have a potential to shine in this game but infrastructures needed are often missing.

Because of withdrawal of affiliation by All India Sports Council of the Deaf in a highly arbitrary manner, we have not been able to take part in the national events as even if the teams are sent, they are prevented from participating. As we do not wish to make it an issue, we have been abiding our time. Also, as the matter is subjudice, Association having challenged the disaffiliation in a court of law, it is better to await a judicial decision.

Now reverting to the performance during the year 2003-04, as stated earlier, since participation in nationals is denied, all that Association could do was to participate in the zonal meets and or organise zonal meets of its own. In addition, it can and does hold Delhi State Games of the Deaf annually.

During 2003-2004, 32nd Delhi Games of the Deaf were held on 7th Feb. 2004 at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium. As always, Sports Authority of India, very graciously allowed as the use of main arena at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi for which Association places on record, its indebtedness to Director General Sports Authority of India.

More than a dozen organizations, institutions took part in these Games, Association was able to make proper arrangements despite financial constraints.

In addition to organizing 32nd Delhi Games of the Deaf, Association also participated in New Delhi YMCA Athletics for Physically Challenged, 7th DDA Cricket Tournament of the Deaf, Delhi Cricket Association of the Deaf Tournament and organized the 1st Northern Interstate Cricket Tournament, in which teams from Punjab, Haryana, U.P and Delhi Participated.

The last event for 2004-05 was 33rd Delhi Games of the Deaf which were held on 16th Feb. 2005. As the Sports Authority of India could not allot the main arena at JLN stadium, due to technical reasons, the sports meet was held at Chhatrashal Stadium, Model Town, Delhi

The details are appended.
