

I am also privileged to hold these games continuously since 2002 as Hony Sports Secretary of Delhi Association of the Deaf. Further we also organised 7th Northern inter-state Cricket tournament. Brief Report of the Games: The Delhi Games were held on 2 December, 2024 at prestigious Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi. Ten Deaf Schools from Delhi & Five Deaf NGOs/ Associations honored us by participating in the event. Almost 400 Players (boys & girls) participated in 30 types of different sports events. There were no fees to participate in the Games. All players were very much excited & eager to give their best to win the prize. The event started at 9:00 AM with Oath Ceremony. Office bearers of Delhi Association of the Deaf lead the Oath Ceremony. Then President and General Secretary of the Association addressed the participants and myself explained to all participants about rules & regulations of the tournament and advised to play in friendly environment. After the briefing the event started under supervision of Field officers and volunteers. Each type of the competition was held for both Girls and Boys separately. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners were given Medal & Certificates. Further trophies were given to winner Schools/NGOs/Associations. The participants were being served whole day with drinking water, healthy drink, medicines, biscuits etc. Tea was served to office bearers of School/NGOs/ Associations & volunteers. In afternoon all participants, office bearers of School/NGOs/Associations & volunteers were distributed Lunch box. Being large number of participants the games ended around at 6.00 PM. The whole event went hassle free & I am much thankful to all the participants for this. Many Social Activist honored us as with their gracious presence as Chief Guest & Guest of honor. At the end of the event Chief Guest & Guest of Honor addressed the gathering and praised the association for holding such sports event for differently abled persons. Then prize were distributed to all the winners. The 7th Northern inter-state Cricket tournament was held on 20-21 March, 2025 at Talkatora Stadium Delhi. This event could not have been so successful without co-operation or help of Sponsors/ advertisers/participants and volunteers and our executive members as well. 


