


During the past decade I am overwhelmed to see several deaf cricketers playing almost at par with normal cricketers. The Deaf have established during this period a separate Olympics. Many Deaf sports men have now toured the globe and have won several laurels including the coveted Arjuna Awards. The most recent one was holding of the Australia vs India cricket Test Cricket of the Deaf. Seeing these events I was thrilled to visualise the facts of life. The Deaf having lost two vital organs gifted by nature to humans are shining very well in the sports field even though they lack proper training and encouragement.

The Organisers — The All India Sports Council of the Deaf have now made it a tradition to win laurels at all levels. With active cooperation from its state bodies they have progressed well.

My sincere thanks to the Delhi Association of the Deaf, who are pioneer in rehabilitation activities of the Deaf, the donores and well wishers.

In this International Year of the Disabled Persons I dedicate myself for the cause of the handicapped.

Ever Onward . . .

It is almost sixteen years, from the time when the first All India Cricket Championship of the Deaf was organised at Hyderabad in 1965. Games of Cricket had by then become popular among the deaf. Earlier they had to content themselves with playing in isolation at local levels. Due to set back of formative years the 2nd National of the Deaf in Cricket was held in 1974 after a lapse of about 8 years. The period of lapse served as the period of consolidation sending were of cricket spirit among the deaf throughout the country.

Since then we have never looked back. The National is being organised regularly every alternative year.

Year 1978, however, proved a turning point in history of the deaf when a five Test Cricket series was organised between Australian and Indian National teams of the Deaf at Hyderabad, New Delhi, Kanpur, Jamshedpur, and Bombay. The series ended in a draw with each side winning one test. India and Australia thus jointly made it possible to make game of cricket International among the deaf.

Number of teams kept on increasing in the National. Beginning from knock-out system, we adopted league-cum-knock out method of play. For the sake of Games we further decided to hold the National Championship on league basis.

Thus to further interest of the game and avoid strain on player Zonal system of Championship has been started from current year. In the National to be held in Haryana in November 1981, 'Champion Zone' as well as 'Champion State' will be decided. We are most likely to witness a very very spirited play and are also confident to spot new talents, which will ultimately help us in fielding a strong team against Pakistan in the proposed series of Test Cricket Matches between the two countries to be organised in the first quarter of the year 1982.

The Delhi Association of the Deaf has undertaken to host this 1st North Zone Cricket Championship of the Deaf at DDCA Kotla Grounds, New Delhi through October 12 to 18, 1981. The Organising Committee of the Championship has made elaborate arrangements for the successful conduct of matches as well as comfortable stay of the players. We wish them all success.
