## REPORT

Respected Sahaniji, Brothers and Sisters,

This is my proud privilege to welcome you to the 27th Anniversary Celebration of the Delhi Association of the Deaf.

On May 29, 1977, we achieved an unique feat, which resulted from almost five years hectic efforts, the Merger of New Delhi Deaf & Dumb Club (1960) with the Deaf & Dumb Association (1950). Unity so forged, will pave way for forming a consolidated body of the Deaf in Delhi by merging almost all radical groups, mushroomed, during the years of precipitation. This will be the beginning of a new era, when each and every Deaf of Delhi can look with confidence on a single body for their 'Total Rehabilitation' instead of knocking the doors of this or that particular organisation. This is what in most serious sense we wish to achieve with the goodwill and cooperation of all concerned.

It will be very difficult task to maintain unity—but with restrain, self—discipline and with a dedicated spirit of forget and forgive and with determined wish to look ahead and progress, I am sure we will be not only able to maintain the unity but also to cement all difference of opinion, method of work etc.

I have the privilege of attending an International Conference on Deafness held in August '77 in Copenhagen, Denmark. While the celebrations of the Conference, it is to be seen, may help advancement of the Deaf community around the world, my own frank assesment is that India has many thing to learn in the field of rehabilitation of the Deaf and has to work hard to catch-up with the standard of living, education, and social adjustment achieved by the deaf in advanced countries. This work can't be done by the voluntary organisations entirely on their own, but the Govts, States as well as the Central, will have to come forward and help this process in all possible manners. Prolonged dependence on charity and donations, can't make useful citizens, but sharing of responsibility among the govt., voluntary organisations and the benefactors themselves can make the deaf, useful, contributing and independent citizens of the country. The country is destined to benefit from this vast manpower resources, i.e. the deaf population, who have proved themselves, as hard working people. If given opportunity, they can well compete with their normal brethren.

The Govt. has taken a right step in the right direction to reserve 3% of employment potential under its disposal for the physically handicapped (class II & III Services). But it will not be enough. The Govt. should come-out with a guarantee of employment to all physically handicapped persons.

To Delhi Administration our appeal is to open at least two more schools for the Deaf. Delhi is number three in population in the country. Metropolis like Bombay, Calcutta, Madras are having 11,6 and 6 most advanced schools for the Deaf respectively. Delhi has only two, one very recently started. Ratio of the teachers and the taught in Delhi is 1 : 12, when it should be 1 : 6. Result is that product of Delhi School come no-where in comparison with products of Bombay and Madras schools. I am sure the Chief Executive Councillor will take note of this fact and help his hearing handicapped brethren by giving them opportunity of proper basic education. It will be more helpful, if the school of the Deaf is transferred to Education Department for expert management.

It will also be helpful, if the Delhi Transport Undertaking considers concession pass to the deaf as is available in Hyderabad.

**Recreation Club :** For healthy recreation of our members the club is functioning since 1950. It has seen many ups and downs but it has lived up to its objective. We stress on visual method of recreation. T.V. set and regular film shows are added attraction. Thanks to All

India Federation of the Deaf for allowing us to run the Club at 4 A, Rouse Avenue Lane, New Delhi.

**Library and Reading Room :** To educate our members and to keep them abreast of latest national and international developments, we maintain a Library and Reading Room. It was started in 1955 and has now about 3000 selected books on culture, art, history, and social services. Important journals are also subscribed.

**Cycle Stands :** For the employment of our untrained members we have been maintaining four Cycle Stands through the good offices of NDMC, Rajghat Samadhi, and some other Govt. offices. We wish that more cycle stands should be allotted us.

**Counselling :** Proper guidance and advice for rehabilitation and social adjustment of the deaf is a must. Their happiness in life is directly related to the nature and extent of guidance and counselling they receive. Our this service has lived upto its expectation and its field of activities covers the whole aspects of the life of the deaf e.g. education, training, employment, marriage and social adjustment.

**Cultural Activities :** Our cultural activities consist of meetings, private and public get-together, performance of Mime and Drama at various levels. Our mime performances at Kanpur, Lucknow, Delhi and Gauhati were acclaimed by press and public. Our performance in Delhi was telecasted on T.V.

**Training Centre for Deaf Girls :** It was started in 1967 to provide vocational training to deaf girls in cutting and stitching of Gents, Ladies, and Kiddies garments, embroidery and machine knitting. It has so far trained about 50 trainees, all of whom are well settled.

**Mook Preeti :** This commercial-cum-display shop of the products of the deaf from all over India is our most ambitious project. It is a step further in realising our aim of self dependence and to find new venues for self employment of our members.

**Batik & Fabric Painting Centre :** We encourage our housewife members to learn Batik and Fabric Painting and to supplement their family income. We market their products.

**Sports :** For the development of personality, physique, discipline and spirit for competition organisation of Sports Meets has been our regular feature. We have won individual and team honours in All India Meets. Our two members participated in Silent Olympics held in Sweden in 1973. This has been made possible due to our intensive coaching programmes and material help to sportsmen and women alike. We have so far organised eight Delhi State Games of the Deaf. To add to our honour we won 2nd All India Cricket Championship of the Deaf in 1974 and thus became the First State team to retain the coveted General Cariappa Rolling Shield.

**Delhi Foundation of Deaf Women :** Our policy has been to encourage cooperative movements which has resulted in the formation of DFDW.

This sister organisation is very dear to us and is receiving our full moral and material support. Since we have similar goal we are working in complete harmony.

**Cooperative :** Badhir Printers a printing press has been started by the association to promote cooperative movement among the Deaf. Its shares have been fully subscribed by the Association and its members. Many more cooperative ventures are on the way.

**Special Mention :** I can't restrain myself from congratulating our Member Sri T.M. Jacob, for his selection on merit for the award of National Scholarship for Studies Abroad for the year 1977-78. He is perhaps the first handicapped to get the unique distinction of being a National Scholar. He will do research for his Ph.D degree at Cleavelan, U.S.A. He has our good wishes.)

I must also mention sides, our Member Sri Satish Kumar for his bringing laurel from the XIIIth World Games of the Deaf held in Romania in July 1977. Sri Satish Kumar got Diploma for obtaining 4th place in 25 Km. Reduced Marathon event. He has a long way to go. We wish him all success in sportive life.

For the past twenty seven years, we have been trying our best to build a permanent home for the association. But we have failed not because that we are unable to raise fund for the purpose but because, we did not get a piece of land to build home. Our dream is to house our existing projects under one roof, and start new projects, specially for woman, children, and unemployed deaf. We need about 2500 sq. yds. of land in a centrally located area. I am sure the Chief Executive Councillor, to whom the cause of handicapped is so dear, will be kind enough to help us in this regard.

I end this report with our heartiest gratitude to all helping hands, donors, advertisers, and particularly to Sri Kedar Nath Sahaniji who has encouraged us by his kind presence.



# Delhi Association of the Deaf

## Years of Progress

**October 4, 1950**

At Piccadilli Restaurant, F. Block, Connaught Place, New Delhi M/s Bans Gopal Nigam, Ratan Lal Aggarwal, Vilaity Ram Goyle, Jagdish Chandra Sachdeva, Indernath Chopra and Amrit Lal Tandon discussed the past, present and future of the deaf and decided to form Deaf and Dumb Association Delhi, to work for the rehabilitation of the Deaf through education, training, employment and social adjustment. M/s Bans Gopal Nigam and Ratan Lal Aggarwal were selected as General Secretary and Treasurer respectively with Shri Nigam's residence at 170, Gali Batashan, Chawri Bazar, Delhi as its office.

**December, 1951**

Cricket Match with Y.M.C.A.

**March 19, 1952**

Mr. Harry F. Latshaw, Director of Special Education, Maryland (USA) and Mrs. Latshaw visited the association and were felicitated.

**December 30, 1952**

Farewell party to General K.M. Cariappa (Retd) the retiring First Indian Commander-in-Chief of Indian Army at Massey Hall, YMCA.

**October 4, 1953**

Kum. Shanta Vashista, Education Minister, Delhi State, inaugurated the 3rd Anniversary Celebration of the Association at Town Hall, New Delhi.

**November, 1953**

Association presented a memorandum requesting the Prime Minister to take necessary steps for the rehabilitation of the Deaf.

**May 5, 1954**

Sardar Gurmukh Nihal Singh, Speaker, Delhi State Legislative Assembly inaugurated Library of the Association at 4775, Paharganj, New Delhi in a room free of rent spared by Shri R.L. Aggarwal and family.

**July 10, 1954**

Toys workshop started in another room at 4775, Paharganj, New Delhi.

**September 1954**

New Delhi Municipal Committee allotted a Cycle Stand, Opp. Singer Sewing Machine Co., Connaught Place on nominal rent for the employment of the deaf. Shri Duni Chand Nagwani was appointed as its first keeper.

**Dec. 1954**

Members Onkar Sharma, Devi Singh Chauhan, and Saroj Kumar were employed by New Delhi Municipal Committee through the efforts of the Association and kindness of Late Sri U.B. Basrurkar NDMC Vice-President.

**May 5, 1955**

Sri Satish Chandra I.C.S., Dy Commissioner, Delhi inaugurated first Foundation Day of Library at 4775, Paharganj New Delhi.

**June 3, 1955**

The Association was registered under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and was allotted registration No S-851 of 1955-56.

**August 1, 1955**

Office of the Association shifted to 2144, Bazar Sitaram, Delhi.

Sri B.G. Nigam, General Secretary, attended the Second World Congress of the Deaf held in Jagreb (Yugoslavia) on invitation from World Federation of the Deaf and was elected as its Vice-President.

Rs. 5,000/- and Rs. 2,500/- were sanctioned by Govt. of India and State Govt. of Delhi respectively to finance his participation.

**September 1955**

Representatives of the Association participated in the First Seminar on the Education of the Deaf, organised by Govt. of India at Mussoorie. Most of its suggestions concerning education and employment of the Deaf found place in the resolutions of the Seminar.

**December 20, 1955**

Hosted first All India Conference of the Deaf at Constitution Club, New Delhi under Presidentship of Dr. Shrimali, Union Dy. Minister of Education Delegates of Bengal Deaf & Dumb Association Calcutta, Bombay Deaf & Dumb Society, Bombay, Punjab Organisation of the Deaf, Jullundur, Rajasthan Deaf & Dumb Association Ratangarh, Deaf and Dumb School, Mysore and Assam Deaf and Dumb School, Gauhati attended it. Rs. 1,500/- was sanctioned by Government of India for holding the Conference.

**December 22, 1955**

Founded All India Federation of the Deaf in presence of Dr. Kailash Nath Katju, Union Defence Minister. Shri B.G. Nigam and Shri R.L. Aggarwal were elected as General Secretary and Treasurer of the Federation respectively.

**July 1956**

Amended Constitution approved by the General Body.

Kum. Gurdip Kaur became first woman member of the Executive Committee.

**December 14, 1956**

Dr. Dragoljub Vukotic, President of World Federation of the Deaf, visited our association and was felicitated.

**December 27, 1956**

Hosted reception to Mr. Li Shih-Han Member of the Committee of the China Welfare Association of the Deaf at its Library premises. Dr. Dragoljub Vukotic was also present.

**April 1957**

Central Social Welfare Board sanctioned Rs. 3,000/- towards salaries for Night School teacher and workshop instructor, and purchase of spray machine and Library books for the year 1957-58.

**July 1957**

Workshop and Library shifted to 92, Kamla Market, New Delhi.

**March 10, 1958**

Pt. Gobind Vallabh Pant, Union Home Minister, presided over the seventh Anniversary Celebration of the Association and inaugurated Exhibition of Handicrafts of the

Deaf at Darbar Hall of Municipal Corporation of Delhi.

**April 1958**

Central Social Welfare Board sanctioned Rs. 2822.50 for the purchase workshop Machinery and Library books for the year 1958-59.

**January 20, 1959**

Prime Minister Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, sanctioned 5,000/- from P.M.'s Women and Children Welfare Fund.

**August 1959**

Sri V.R. Goyle, Treasurer participated in Third World Congress of the Deaf held in Weisbaden (West Germany) at his own cost. Sri B.G. Nigam also participated as All India Federation of the Deaf's representative.

**November 1959**

Participated in Second All India Congress of the All India Federation of the Deaf held in Calcutta. Won many prizes in All India Exhibition and Drama Competitions.

M/s Bans Gopal Nigam and Ratan Lal Aggarwal re-elected as General Secretary and Treasurer of the Federation respectively.

**March 19, 1960**

Shri Bhagwan Sahay, Chief Commissioner, Delhi, presided over the 9th Anniversary Celebration of the Association.

**March 20, 1960**

First Charity Show of Dance by the deaf was organised which received thunderous applause and praise from the public.

**July 30, 1961**

Night Education classes for Adult Deaf started.

**July 13, 1962**

Founder Member Sri V.R. Goyle died in a road accident.

**September 13, 1962**

Founder Member Sri Jagdish Chand Sachdeva died of heart failure.

**November 19, 1962**

L. Dina Nath Jhallani, Ex. President died in an accident.

August 1963

Participated in Convention of the Teachers of the Deaf in India held at Bangalore. Sri Onkar Nath Sharma got elected as its Executive Committee Member.

February 24, 1965

Participated in the 2nd All India Deaf & Dumb Sports Meet held at National Stadium, New Delhi. Won Team Championship of Women section and were runners-up in Men section. Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri distributed prizes to the winners.

The All India Sports Council of the Deaf was founded. Shri Onkar Sharma became first General Secretary of the Council.

July 1966

Office of the Association shifted and registered at 92, Kamla Market, New Delhi.

October 4, 1966

Cultural activities of the Association resulted in public presentation of J.S. Jurgney's MUMU, based on a Russian Love Story, at New Delhi—with an all deaf artist cart directed by Sri Satish Sehgal. Artists received high appreciation for their performances.

November 21, 1966

Mumu's staging at All India Fine Art and Craft Hall, New Delhi highly acclaimed by the spectators and the press.

May 21, 1967

Another performance of Mumu at Kanpur, on invitation from Dynamic Young Circle. Sri Prakasha, Ex. Governor, Bombay and Madras inaugurated it.

July 1967

Vice President Onkar Sharma participated in the Convention of International Teachers of the Deaf in Washington USA. The Association financed his participation.

July-August 1967

Sri R.L. Aggarwal attended the Vth World Congress of the Deaf at Warshaw (Poland) and visited Italy, U.K. France, West Germany, Switzerland:

September 13, 1967

Sri Madan Mohan Vashista, Joint Secretary, proceeded to USA for higher studies in the Gallaudet College, Washington, D C.

October 1-4, 1967

17th Anniversary Celebration of the Association at Town Hall, New Delhi.

December 1967

Tailoring Training Centre for Deaf Girls started functioning at 92, Kamla Market, New Delhi.

August 1968

Sri R.L. Aggarwal attended International Conference of Handicapped at Hongkong.

October 19-21, 1968

Hosted 3rd Congress of the All India Federation of the Deaf. Kum. Surrender Saini, R.L. Aggarwal, Onkar Sharma, Suraj Prakash, were elected as Executive Vice-President, Hony. Treasurer and Members of the Executive Committee respectively of AIFD, and Smt. Mukti Uppal and Sri C.P. Kanchanbaras were also elected as members of its Central Committee.

September 13, 1969

Shri Y. B. Chavan, Union Home Minister inaugurated Association's first Commercial Enterprise-cum-Photo Studio-cum Show window of the products of the deaf, "Mook Preeti" at 6B, Yashwant Place, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi.

Rajghat Samadhi Committee and the National Industries Development Corporation allotted cycle stands at Rajghat Samadhi and Chanakya Bhavan respectively on nominal rent.

March 1969

Participated in the 3rd All India Deaf & Dumb Sports Meet organised by All India Sports Council of the Deaf in Calcutta and retained Championship of women group.

Shri Onkar Sharma re-elected General Secretary of the Council. Sri Harish Kumar Chug also got elected to its Executive Board.

March 21, 1970

Shri Vassand Rai Nagwani received National Award for the Best Physically Handicapped Employee from the President of India Shri V. V. Giri.

October 4, 1970

20th Anniversary of the Association celebrated.

**January 20, 1971**

Organised 4th Delhi State Deaf & Dumb Sports Meet at Salwan School Ground. Air Chief Marshal Arjan Singh inaugurated the Meet and Smt. Chand Chhabra distributed prizes to the winners.

**July-August 1971**

Sri. R. L. Aggarwal attended the VIth World Congress of the World Federation of the Deaf held in Paris.

**December 1971**

Shri Onkar Sharma attended CISS Winter Games in Switzerland.

**October 2, 1972**

5th Delhi State Deaf & Dumb Sports Meet inaugurated by Shri Radha Raman, Chief Executive Councillor, Delhi.

**October 19, 1972**

Shri Krishna Swaroop, Executive Councillor, Social Welfare Delhi, presided over the 22nd Anniversary celebration of the association and distributed prizes to the winners of 5th DSSDSM.

**November 1972**
