57th Annual Report

I have the honour to present the Association's annual report for the year 2006-07. I admit at the outset that Association's performance during the year under review has been lack-luster. This was a direct fall out of resources constraint. Though Association tried its best to raise resources on its own but the absence of timely release of grant-in-aid for two consecutive years could not be made up. Therefore, day to day work and normal activities did suffer to an extent but somehow, the work was carried on and the services provided to the members were kept at the normal levels.

The reason for non-release of grant-in-aid can be attributed to the strange ways of functioning of the bureaucracy. While the Directorate of Social Welfare, Delhi was kind enough to recommend release of grant-in-aid for the years 2005-06, 2006-07 knowing well that the grant can not be released in the absence of registration certificate u/s 51-52 of PWD Act 1995 the self same Directorate of Social Welfare kept the Association's application for registration u/s 51-52 of PWD Act 1995 for more than a year. And the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India failed to release the pending grants even after the registration certificate was submitted.

It has to be stressed that NGOs are sharing the responsibility of the Government in extending welfare services to the targeted groups at a fraction of cost of what Government would have spent by directly shouldering the work. This is because of the fact that though the Government boasts of compensating the NGOs to the extent of 90% of their operational costs the formula at which the grants released to the NGOs is not even a fraction of the rates of which Government conducts its own welfare activities.

And even to receive this minimum assistance, NGOs have to bear indignity. Their letters are never replied to Personal access to the officials, unless well connected is denied, and if somehow access is gained, representative of NGOs are given short shift with bad grace. Unless this working culture in the Government departments change, the self-respecting NGO office bearers will think twice before taking up responsibilities for running the NGOs.

To revert to the Association's functioning, it need not be mentioned that due to financial restraints, resulting from non-receipt of grant-in-aid for two years running, the working was adversely affected. However, the Association managed to maintain services available to the members at the same level by mobilizing resources and drawing from its meager saving.

It is a matter of regret that Association could not resolve the dispute with the contractor resigned to complete construction of Association's building for Research & Rehabilitation Centre for the Deaf. As stated earlier, a suit had been filed in a court of law last year, a number of hearings were held and when the time of passing orders came, the handling judge was transferred, resulting in re-scheduling hearing by the new Judge afresh from the very beginning.

For us, there is a sense of emergency. The Delhi Development Authority has fixed 31st Dec. 2007 for completing construction on all plots allotted by it to various persons/parties or face repossession of the plot. In our case half the construction has been completed and the matter being subjudice, we may get some relief but we are making all out efforts to complete the construction within the grace period given by the Delhi Development Authority, subject of course to early court orders.

For the rest, it is a matter of satisfaction for us that despite financial crunch, normal activities, be it sports or games, reading room or library services, assistance to the members in settlement of their personal problems and grievances, playing a pro-active role for securing their rights for persons with disabilities and so on, were augmented to meet the demand of an increasing number of members which now stand at 1450.

During the year under review the Association was able to re-start its Sunday School, thanks to the kind assistance of Shri Rajendra Kumarji Gupta, Secretary, Lala Dewan Chand Trust. Now nearly fifty deaf children of both sexes attend the Sunday School and their numbers are growing. We have a dedicated Instructor Ms Sonu Pandey, who has won the heart of her students.

The Association organized its First Badhir Pranay Milan Sammelan on 16-12-2006 at Hindu Maha Sabha Bhawan, New Delhi. A lot of work, administrative as well resources mobilization was done by our Executive President, Shri Ramesh Gupta, Dr. Bhushan Dawesar and Dr. (Mrs.) Shakuntala Dawesar were the Chief Guest on the occasion and lent their moral as well as material support for which Association will be always grateful to them.

The Association is beholden to Shri Javed Abidi, Executive Director, National Centre for Promotion of Employment for Disabled People, New Delhi who has been spear-heading movement for empowering persons with disabilities, not only for giving a lead for claiming facilities and concessions doled out by the Government, as charity but as a matter of right, but also for the material assistance, comprising of two Computers and one Printer, also two chairs, together valued at Rs.75,000 to the Association. He has always acted as a guide and mentor for our Association as well as a very large number of NGOs working for the welfare of the disabled persons. It was through his efforts that a large number of representatives of NGOs including this Association, that they were co-opted as members of the Working Group on Empowering the Disabled Person during the XI Five Year Plan.

The Association celebrated its 56th Annual Day on Oct. 15, 2006, at the Auditorium of G.B. Pant Hospital, New Delhi. Thanks to the kindness of Dr. Arun Kumar Agarwal, Dean, Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi. Shri Madan Singhji Shekhawat, Dy. Comptroller & Auditor General of India was the Chief Guest. He kindly assured his help to further the good work that the Association was doing. Dr. (Smt.) Shakuntala Dawesar was the Chief Guest and Shri Madhav Pathak, was Guest of Honour, Dr. (Mrs.) Penelope Estabrook also graced the function. The function was largely attended by the Members of the Association and their families.

The Association organized 35th Delhi Games of the Deaf on 10-2-2007 at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi. Over 400 participants drawn from over a dozen institutions and organization of the deaf participated.

It is a matter of satisfaction for the Association that most of the suggestions made by its representative on the Working Group constituted by the Planning Commission for Empowering Disabled Persons during XI Five Year Plan have been accepted by the Government.

Before concluding, I deem it my duty to gratefully acknowledge the support, financial help and advertisement support and to thank them for their generosity and continued support and express hope that it will e forthcoming in future as well.

ASSOCIATION SUFFERS A SET BACK

On 31st Jan 07, Association's then Secretary Shri D.S. Chauhan, who has been its main stay, became a victim of Hit & Run accident. He was in a way discharging his duty to the Association and had gone to attend a dinner hosted by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in the Honour of visiting team of disabled leaders on visit to India, as a part of World Bank team on disability and had availed of the opportunity to brief the visitors about our Association and its various activities.

This resulted in fracture of right hip and thigh joint and led to his confinement to bed for over eight months. Even after that period, he would hardly hobble with support of a cane. Naturally, he could not attend office and discharge his regular duties. The work suffered.

Though in pain, he was ready to extend whatever help the Association needed, if it was brought to his notice at his home. He readily completed annual accounts for the year 2006-07 and prepared balance sheet. Whenever help in correspondence work was needed, he would readily draft replies or initiate correspondence on matters relating to Association's activities again from his home, from his bed.

Though he was game enough, Association was deprived of his services on regular basis. This resulted in serious set back in the working of the Association. In particular, a large number of deaf persons who used to come to seek his help for settlement of their personal problems suffered the most.

Thus the last quarter of the year 2006-07 Association had to do without his services and its cause suffered but only to admitted extent.

The remaining office bearers of the Association rose to the occasion, shouldered responsibilities assigned to them and did whatever was required to be done with ugly. It was because of this that Association's work was continued, though only on a shade lower scale. Efforts were also made to ensure that the individual members received whatever help they needed. Other normal activities were also carried on without let of hindrance.

Association successfully organized 36th Delhi Games of the Deaf on 5th February at Chhatrashal Stadium, Model Town-III, Delhi in which several hundred deaf athletes participated. Several new records were set during the sports meet and the arrangements made were at par with those made during the earlier years.

Library and Reading Room functioned as before and the members availed of these services in large number.

During the year under review a number of visitors from abroad came to the office and were impressed by the work being done by the Association, so much so that a number of them promised assistance to the Association to give boost its activities. The impact of these visits will be available during the coming months.

The only major failure was inability of the Association to convey its General Body Meeting and hold elections as per schedule. This is being done now and hopefully, in future all the scheduled activities, meetings shall be held as usual.

Amendment of Persons with Disabilities Act 1995

Recommendations made to the Union Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment by DELHI ASSOCIATION OF THE DEAF - New Delhi


We understand the Government is to amend Persons with Disabilities Act 1995.

We submit the following suggestions for incorporating in the Persons with Disabilities Act 1995, while amending it and shall be grateful if these are included in the amended Act.

- 1 In all the Committees, constituted by the Government in accordance with Persons with Disabilities Act (PWD Act), at least one sign language user deaf must be included. In other words, only deaf should represent deaf and no hearing person should represent the deaf.
- 2 No deaf child shall be denied admission in special/integrated school. In integrated schools deaf, if they so want, shall be taught in sign language.
- 3 More schools for the Deaf shall be opened, existing schools for the deaf should be up graded Primary to Middle, Middle to Secondary and Secondary to Higher Secondary level.
- 4 Sign Language based colleges shall be established for the deaf, at least one in each State.
- 5 Ultimately, a sign language based university, on the lines of Gallaudet University, Washington, U.S.A. shall be opened.
- 6 Adequate training institutions for the deaf on the lines of I.T.Is. shall be opened and manned with sign language trained instructors.
- 7 Those deaf people who want to learn through oral system of education in which use of sign language is not allowed, shall have the freedom of do so and for their benefit, oral system schools should be established.
- 8 Government shall arrange for early identification and intervention, as early as possible but in no case later than two years after the birth of the deaf child. The parents shall have option to admit such deaf children in special schools for the deaf with a choice to opt for oral method or visual method (sign language based).
- 9 Efforts shall be made to teach a deaf children at least 15,000-20,000 words/signs and then have them integrated in schools for normal children.
- 10 The Government shall enable persons with disabilities to learn life and social development skills and make arrangements for promotion of sign language and preservation of deaf culture and linguistic identity of deaf.
- 11 Government shall open more Teachers Training institution to train teachers for deaf both oral system users or sign language users.
- 12 Government shall help NGOs working for the welfare of deaf by extending generous grants to help them run their Associations, clubs, Institutions, special schools, training centres, rehabilitations, cultural, sports activities and so on.

- 13 Government shall ensure that deaf get adequate opportunities for employment in private, public sectors as well as in the Deptt. and offices of Government, civic bodies etc.
- 14 Unemployment allowances adequate to support self, shall be given in case the Government fails to find employment for the deaf.
- 15 In departmental as well as common recruitment tests, conducted by the Staff Selection Commission of Central or State Government, separate tests shall be held for deaf, a separate, easy paper set and evaluated keeping in view the poor linguistic skills of the deaf, to fill up 1% posts reserved for the deaf.
- 16 For helping those deaf who wish to be self employed, training and technical know how shall be arranged by the Government, after training, funds at easy rate of interest shall be given, space (shop, kiosk etc.) provided for setting up business by the deaf.
- 17 Deaf who have communicating disabilities shall be provided sign language trained interpreters at hospitals, major public dealing offices etc. at Government cost.
- 18 Deaf shall have a right to marry, raise family, earn, inherit property and hold it. No parent shall deny deaf his/her share of family's assets.
- 19 Government shall make all our efforts to develop a standard Indian sign language for the deaf, in consultation and with the approval of the deaf community and promote and propagate it through all available media of mass communication, print/visual.
- 20 Films/News on T.V. serials telecast etc. shall carry sub-titles and once a standard Indian Sign Language is put in place, running commentary in sign language shall be given when ever required at public functions etc.
- 21 Government shall ensure that deaf and orthopaedically disabled get driving licences. However, in the case of orthopaedically disabled, the vehicle must be modified/adapted according the need of the person.
- 22 A chapter on deaf related issues, including sign language shall be included in all training courses right from nursery level teachers or village *Patwari* to the I.A.S./I.P.S.
- 23 Deaf shall have right to lead a satisfying and fulfilling life and Government shall ensure that this happens.
- 24 Deaf shall have a right to access and seek justice from a Court of Law as and when necessary and the Government shall ensure that this happens.
- 25 As Special Employment Exchanges for the Physically Handicapped and V.R.Cs for Physically Handicapped have not been of much help to Deaf, the work of sponsoring deaf candidates for various posts shall be given to NGOs working for the deaf and they shall receive adequate grant to discharge this duty.

आजकल यह सामान्य तौर पर देखा जाता है कि विवाह योग्य बधिर युवा वर्ग आत्मसम्मान व आत्मनिर्भरता के साथ अपना भावी गृहस्थ जीवन बिताने का सपना देखता रहता है, लेकिन सामाजिक व पारिवारिक सहयोग और प्रोत्साहन के अभाव में शादी की समस्या जटिल बनी हुई है, दूसरी बात यह है कि माँ पिता और संरक्षक भी अपने विवाह योग्य बधिर बच्चों की शादी की समस्या और सही योग्य जीवन साथी की तलाश की परेशानी से जूझते रहे हैं आदि- इन समस्याओं के समाधान की दिशा में हम ने देश भर में जहाँ कहीं भी रहते हुए विवाह योग्य बधिर युवक-युवतियों को एक ही सही स्थान पर इकट्ठा करके एक दूसरे के परिचय व जानकारी के आदान-प्रदान का लाभ उठाकर पवित्र रिश्ता-सम्बन्ध स्थापित करने का अवसर उपलब्ध कराया।

एक और उल्लेखनीय बात यह है कि हम इसी आयोजन में प्रवेश और पंजीकरण की शुल्क भी दूसरी अन्य संस्थाओं के मुकाबले बहुत कम कराने के प्रयत्न में कामयाब रह चुके हैं इतना ही नहीं, यहाँ तक कि बधिर युवती वर्ग के लिए शुल्क से राहत (मुक्त) की सुविधा भी दिलाने में सफल हो चुके हैं-इन सब सुविधाओं की बजह से उपस्थित सही विवाह योग्य बधिर युवक युवतियों के चेहरों पर खिले फूल की तरह मुस्कराहट देखी जा सकी।



Association Wins Court Case

Contractor ordered to vacate Association's Plot and handover its vacant possession to Association.

After exhausting all available normal options for arriving at a mutually satisfactory understanding and agreement with Shri Arun Sharma, Proprietor, Shri Balaji & Associates, the firm of contractor entrusted by the Association with the task of constructing the Association's Building to house its Research and Rehabilitation Centre for the Deaf, Association was forced to file a civil suit in a court of law against the contractor to regain possession of its plot located at C-12 Qutub Institutional Area, New Delhi.

It may be stated here that the contractor's work was not satisfactorily, he was using substandard material and dragging his feet, deliberately delaying the construction. He was served with several communications, pointing out short-comings also notices to improve and speed up work but to which he paid no heed.

As a final resort, contractor's services were terminated. But before taking this extreme step, Association held numerous meetings with the contractor in the presence of impartial, leading social workers to persuade him to restore possession of the plot to Association, accept a honourable compensation of Rs. five lacs but regrettably, he obstructed every attempt aimed at arriving at an amical agreement.

He, instead, demanded Rs. fifteen lacs without having laid a single brick after he was ordered to stop work. Then he continued to shift his stand, some times agreeing to do the remaining part of work (first floor & 2nd floors), then declining to do so. His quantum of compensation continued to fluctuate. There was thus no meeting ground.
